



MICHEL LYNCH PRESTIGE

AOC SAINT-ÉMILION 2020 14,5%

This wine pays tribute to Michel Lynch, a name that is inextricably linked with the great wines of Bordeaux. Born in 1754, he devoted his life to improving the wines on his estate now known as Château Lynch-Bages.

The wine that bears his name has passed through the hands of a renowned winemaking team.

It is crafted from a selection of the Bordeaux vineyard's noblest grapes, which have been harvested at maturity and carefully vinified.

Michel Lynch Prestige celebrates the region's greatest local appellations. These are exceptional wines that faithfully reflect both the local terroir and its grape varietals.

Vintage conditions

The mild and particularly rainy winter, followed by a wet spring, created a lot of concern but turned out to be a decisive advantage for this vintage! Once the mildew problems had been elimnated, the soft warmth at the end of June provided very favorable conditions for the vineyard's development. Throughout the sunny summer, the vines had good reserves and has tapped into rich soil. The regular and early flowering, followed by a more spread veraison allowed a homogeneous harvest which took place on 24th and 25th September with perfect sanitary conditions.

Tasting notes

The Saint-Emilion 2020 has a deep and shiny purple color.

Powerful, the bouquet develops small black fruits (blackberries, blueberries) and spices aromas. Silky and delicate, the palate reveals a pleasant density, ripe and velvety tannins with bigarreau cherry and vanilla notes.

The finish is fresh, long and very elegant.

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It is crafted from a selection of the Bordeaux vineyard's noblest grapes, which have been harvested at maturity and carefully vinified.

Michel Lynch is an elegant and fruit-forward wine, a perfect reflection of its rich terroir, one of the most prestigious in the world. The cuvee is partly aged in oak barrels and produced in limited quantity.

Vintage conditions

The mild and particularly rainy winter, followed by a wet spring, created a lot of concern but turned out to be a decisive advantage for this vintage! Once the mildew problems had been eliminated, the soft warmth at the end of June provided very favorable conditions for the vineyard's development. Throughout the sunny and hot summer, the vines had good reserves and has tapped into rich soil. The regular and early flowering was followed by a more spread veraison.

From September, the hot days and cool nights generate a rapid evolution of maturity and a very good sanitary condition of the vines, that's allowed a homogeneous harvest.

Tasting notes

With a brilliant and golden color, Michel Lynch Prestige Sauternes offers a seductive aromatic richness on the nose, with a beautiful concentration. Already pleasant to taste, the 2020 vintage presents a beautiful structure with notes of exotic fruits and a touch of honey. Nice length in the mouth.
